Please note the following:

- Candidates sitting for the exam should arrive at their examination venue not later than **08:15am**.

Note: British Council may conduct the practical tests at any convenient time **or times within the range allowed by the examining board for all attached centres.**

The candidates are not all required to take the tests at the same time, and they do not need to be sequestered until the other candidate have taken the test. Therefore, if we have large numbers of candidates entered for the exam, it is permissible to divide them into two or three separate 'sittings' of the papers.

- **Parents are not allowed on premises at all times during the examinations.**
- **Every school should have a school representative with an authorized letter from the school's co-ordinator to accompany candidates to the exam venue.**
- School representatives are not allowed to accompany candidates inside the examination laboratories.
- **Students arriving to the examination venue out of their school uniform will not be permitted to sit for the examinations under any circumstances.**

No Mobiles phones are allowed into the examination hall or laboratories during practical examinations. Candidates may be disqualified from the examination session if they fail to comply with CIE regulations.

1.2 Seat numbers

Your seat number changes for every examination. Before each examination you must check your hall and seat number on the venue noticeboard.

1.3 Clashes

2. Listening / IT & Science practical examinations:

Please check with your school the separate instructions for practical (Biology, Chemistry and Physics) and listening examinations.

3. Exam day instructions:

- 3.1 Security regulations state that "No candidate will be allowed to leave before the end of the examination session".
- 3.2 Candidates are not allowed to take from the examination room used examination papers. A complete set of question papers will be sent to schools after the end of the examination period.



3.3 **NO MOBILE PHONES** are allowed into the examination hall or at laboratories during practical examinations. Candidates may be disqualified from the examination session if they do not abide by CIE rules.

- 3.4 The British Council is not responsible for handbags and valuables left unattended. Please make it a point not to bring such things with you.
- 3.5 **The replacement of a lost Identification Card (ID) will cost LE 30.**
- 3.6 **You are NOT allowed to come to the examination venue except with your full summer school uniform (any type of hats or caps is not permitted).**
- 3.7 **Students arriving at the venue out of their school uniform will not be permitted to sit for the examinations under any circumstances.**
